The following proposal was presented:

a. A Controlled Study to Determine the Clinical Value of Combinations Together in Total Body Perfusion (total body Washout or TBW) in the Resuscitation and Subsequent Survival of Patients in Hypotensive Shock. Principal Investigator - Gerald Klinefelter, AFMRC 7-1.

The committee returned the proposal without action for the following reasons: 1) It felt that the criteria for patient exclusion were not explicit. 2) The statistical design should include patient cross-over in both directions. 3) Questions were raised regarding the frequency of administration regarding patient safety and neurological status evaluation. 4) The protocol did not specify who would make decisions regarding the undertaking of the protocol.

The following additional information was specifically requested for addition to a modified, embellished protocol. If the investigator chooses to resubmit: 1) provide the committee with newspaper article of bibliography "in press". 2) list of collaborators and their roles. 3) letters of willingness and capability from the CIC, Clinical Laboratory, to verify blood availability and laboratory capabilities.
