MEMORANDUM FOR Ms. Violet Trainer, Chief, Resource Management Br
SUBJECT: Autologous Erythrocyte Infusion Study

1. As you requested, I am providing a general plan for executing the Autologous Erythrocyte Infusion Study (APMD-92001-AP001-H001) to assist you in managing the funds for this study:

First Quarter FY93 - Subject recruitment;

Second Quarter FY93 - Collect 1 unit blood on two separate occasions;

Third and Fourth Quarter FY93 - data collection at USARIEM and Pikes Peak, CO.

2. It is anticipated that one to three persons will have to perform about 3 days of TDY at a military Post within CONUS during the recruitment of subjects. During the second and third quarter of FY93, orders for supplies and equipment will be placed. The majority of funds will be expended during the third and fourth quarters of FY93 to pay for freight and TDY expenses of subjects and staff during the data collection phase.


3. Ms. Deanna Bennet, Tech Base Manager, USSOCOM SORDEC, has advised me that she anticipates providing us with the SOCOM portion (\$99,000 total) of the funding as follows:

First Quarter FY93 - \$24,000

Second Quarter FY93 - \$25,000

Third Quarter FY93 - \$50,000
