

SUBJECT: Human Radiation Research

1. Reference memorandum, AMEDD Center and School, HSMC-GCI, 15 Feb 94, Subject: Human Radiation Research.
2. Patterson Army Community Hospital (PACH) is a small hospital whose radiology department is limited to diagnostic x-ray and mammography. There is no record of any other types of procedures ever being performed.
3. Preventive Medicine records are available back to 1987, Annual Historical Reports are destroyed after 5 years IAW AR 40-226, and no other records seem to be in existence.
4. The hospital radiologist, Dr. Helen Lim, has been here at PACH since 1977 and she stated that no research has been performed since she has been here.
5. The CECOM Safety Office's Health Physics Branch was contacted and they stated that they also were unaware of any radiation research ever being performed at PACH. (CECOM Safety chairs the installation's Radiation Control Committee and provides the installation with a radiation protection officer).
