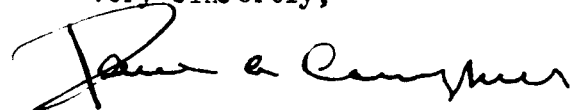
My dear Captain Shilling:

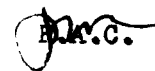
As you are intimately interested in Aviation Medicine I would sincerely appreciate a list of titles and authors which you might suggest for our program.
