1. It is requested that the following fixed-price contract be initiated:

- a. Contractor: The Sloan-Kettering Institute for Cancer Research
- b. Principal investigator: Dr. James J. Nickson
- c. Amount: \$21,892
- d. Duration: 1 November 1957 - 31 October 1958
- e. Subject work; To study the post-irradiation syndrome in humans.

2. Negotiation of this contract is necessary because the nature of the work involved does not lend itself to formal advertising. The contractor has been recommended by the Armed Forces Special Weapons Project, after careful consideration of the capabilities of the investigator and the facilities available to him to carry on the work.
