1. In connection with the 7.0 program to be conducted by this organization and the program involving two (2) B-50A's, now attached to this unit, it is requested that authority be granted this unit to permit total radiation dosage of 3.0 roentgens in any one (1) twenty-four (24) hour period for personnel involved in the conduct of flights where such exposure is considered advisable in order to complete the mission to the extent desired. Personnel receiving dosages of 3.0 roentgens will be restricted to exposure of 0.1 roentgens for the remainder of the project.

2. Since the requirements of the 7.0 program and the B-50A program are those promulgated by Commander, Task Group 3.1, the requirements and justification for this request will not be repeated in this letter.




