**SUBJECT:** Activation of Program 4, Operation CASTLE

1. Reference is made to:

- a. Commanding General, Joint Task Force Seven message 051118Z March 1954 to the Armed Forces Special Weapons Project, giving latest estimates of significant nuclear dosages received by exposed personnel.
- b. AFSPW message DUC051927Z to CG JTF Seven, requesting activation of Program 4.
- c. CG JTF Seven message 06054Z March 1954 to AFSPW, approving subject project.
- d. AFSPW message 47975 to CG JTF Seven, advising project personnel and equipment departing Washington 6 March.
- e. Briefing of Dr. Starks on this problem by COL G. F. Blunda on 5 March 1954.

2. It is understood that following the briefing of Dr. Starks by COL Blunda, Dr. Starks briefed you and that you gave verbal concurrence to the activation of subject program, the objective of which is to study the response of human beings exposed to significant beta and gamma radiation due to fallout from high yield weapons. This memorandum is to inform you officially of the action taken by the AFSPW in this urgent and important program and to confirm your verbal approval.

3. It is estimated that the funds involved in this program are: extra military: \$10,000; R&D: \$40,000; and that these funds are avail-

OBJECTIVE: To study the response of human beings in the Marshall Islands who may have received significant radiation doses from an atomic detonation.

ESTIMATED FUNDS: Extra-Military \$10,000. R&D \$40,000.

3. Program will be under Task Unit 13. Funds will be provided from R&D and Extra-Military Funds available for DOD programs for Operation CASTLE.

BACKGROUND: Accidental exposure has apparently occurred to allow such a program to be implemented and if so, it is essential to the DOD that it be implemented without delay. In accordance with Reference 1, Project personnel and equipment being assembled in DC for airlift to Kwajalein for implementation in this program.

4. Request JTF-7 render all possible assistance in this matter, including JTF-7 priority for movement from Travis for personnel and equipment.

5. Continuation of this program depends on personnel being exposed to significant doses. Therefore, request expeditiously latest estimate of dosage received by exposed personnel referred to above to determine whether dosage sufficient to warrant continuance of this program. CDR Cronkite with Project personnel and equipment will proceed to Travis AFB pending receipt of your estimate.

Project 4.1 study of response of human beings exposed to significant Gamma and Beta radiation due to high yield weapons is approved.

Part 2: Some personnel evacuated from Rongelap are believed to have recd 130 roentgens. This figure is based upon revised calculations which have been completed only recently. At least 3 of the personnel USAF Weather Detachment Rongerik recd 98 roentgens as determined by film badges. Natives evacuated from Utirik recd approx 17 roentgens prior to leaving that atoll.

Part 3. For JTF 7 LNO Travis. Request all possible assistance including necessary assignment of class 1 priorities be rendered Cdr Cronkite for both the movement of personnel and equipment to Kwajalein.

Part 4. Request that clearance status of all project personnel be forwarded this hq. Minimum of SECRET clearance will be required for participation this project.

Part 5. Funding in accordance with annex E, CJTF 7 Admin Order 2-53.


