Shipment 6998-01, consisting of one (1) officer and twenty (20) airmen departed Tinker Air Force Base via MATS to the Port of Aerial Embarkation on 3 September. Shipment 6998-01, consisting of three (3) officers and eight (8) airmen departed via 6th Weather Group's C-47 on 11 September. Shipment 6998-01, consisting of eight (8) officers and eight (8) airmen departed via MATS on 23 September. Travis Air Force Base was the Port of Aerial Embarkation for all increments of shipment 6998 from Tinker Air Force Base. All increments of shipment 6998 were divided at either Travis or Hickam Air Force Bases with the exception of 6998-01. The members of these increments were airlifted singly or in small groups on a space available basis rather than as integral troop movements. Lieutenant Colonel Raymond B. Girardo, USAF, Commander of Joint Task Force Weather Central, was a part of shipment 6998-01 but proceeded to Eniwetok rather than to Kwajalein as the rest of the increment did. One airman departed Tinker Air Force Base on 2 October and arrived Kwajalein on 10 October, also as a part of 6998-01. He was not counted in the figures above in order to avoid confusion.

Detachment WREP-1 landed at Bikini on 16 September and was operational by 26 September. WREP-2 landed at Majuro on 28 August and was operational by 20 September. WREP-3 landed at Kusaie on 3 September and was operational by 23 September. WREP-4 landed at Ponape on 6 September and was operational by 25 September.

Each of the detachments encountered many varied problems in be-

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being organized and operational. The dates in the preceding paragraph tell when operations commenced, but in all cases detachments were not well organized until some time after those dates. Because the detachments were set up as self sufficient organizations with problems of food, shelter, medical facilities, communications, supply, storage, and other problems which do not ordinarily concern a weather detachment, they seemed to have problems far out of proportion to their comparatively small sizes.

Shipment 6998-LI arrived at Kwajalein on 15 September at 1100 hours. Immediately upon arrival personnel were billeted and later that same day started cleaning and preparing the allotted office space for use as the Headquarters of Weather Reporting Element 132.4.3.2, Provisional. The upper bay of building 1127 was assigned for use of the element. By 17 September the Headquarters was cleaned, furnished, and in operation. The personnel to man the Headquarters consisted of a Commanding Officer, Deputy Commanding Officer, First Sergeant, Personnel Supervisor, Personnel Clerk, Supply Supervisor, Supply Clerk, two Ravinsonde Operators, and two Weather Observers. The Ravinsonde Operators and Weather Observers were assigned the duty of checking all Surface and Upper Air Observations taken at the detachments.

All personnel of the Weather Central arrived between 17 September⁵ and 1 October and the Weather Central was operational by 25 September. Since then the Weather Central has been receiving and evaluating all weather reports from the detachments and permanent stations in their area for the purpose of making forecasts for the Joint Task Force. On

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23 September a message was sent from Air Weather Service Headquarters in Washington to the 2143rd Air Weather Wing advising them to place their detachment at Eniwetok under operational control of Test Services Unit 132.4.3 until the end of the project. Administrative control and personnel records remained under control of the 2143rd Wing. This meant that the normal complement of the Eniwetok Weather Station was merged with personnel of Task Element 132.4.3.2 to form the Joint Task Force Weather Central. The duty of checking and recording the weather records from Eniwetok was assigned to the Headquarters Checking Section of Task Element 132.4.3.2 at Kwajalein.

All detachments, Weather Central, and Headquarters at Kwajalein were connected on a radio network for the transmission of weather reports from the detachments and their reception by Weather Central and Headquarters. AACS at Kwajalein intercepted the messages and acted as a monitor for the network. After keeping a log for a few days, it was evident that AACS at Kwajalein was not intercepting all messages successfully so Weather Central was advised to also keep a log. The log kept at Kwajalein by the Headquarters Checking Section was for the purpose of evaluating the efficiency of Kwajalein's interceptions and monitoring. A transmission schedule was published by this headquarters and issued to all stations of the network. Four (4) fifteen (15) minute periods were set aside each day for the exchange of administrative messages. This was done to insure that the detachments would have a radio operator on guard during those periods. Otherwise, trying to contact detachments between weather transmissions would be a hit or miss proposition, depending on whether or

not an operator was on guard. The detachments, Weather Central, and Headquarters were assigned call signs as follows: Kwajalein (Headquarters), 2EL; Eniwetok (Weather Central), 2EL1; Bikini (WREP-1), 2EL5; Majuro (WREP-2), 2EL3; Kusaie (WREP-3), 2EL2; Ponape (WREP-4), 2EL4. On 3 October a message was sent from Headquarters advising Weather Central and all detachments that henceforth the weather islands would use station numbers besides the radio call signs on weather reports, excepting Bikini. These numbers were: for Bikini, ///; for Majuro, 376; for Kusaie, 356; and for Ponape 8 3-8. Previous to this message all stations had been using only radio call signs which made their reports useless to anyone but Task Force Weather Central. In the letter accompanying the transmission schedule a rule was set stating that emergency messages had preference over all others.

Because the detachments were set up in isolated areas there was no practical way to reach them except by aircraft. Arrangements had been made with the VP-2 Squadron (Navy) at Kwajalein to provide aircraft and crews for flights to the detachments. These flights have been invaluable for inspections and conference purposes between Headquarters and the detachments. Their main value, as planned, has been for supply, resupply, and delivery of Post Exchange goods and motion picture films for troop recreational facilities. A regular schedule was set up for the flights to Ponape on Mondays, Kusaie on Tuesdays, Majuro on Thursdays, and Bikini on Fridays. This schedule has been followed to within one day since its advent about 1 October. Because all locations but Majuro lack landing strips, all flights, with the exception of a few C-47 flights to Majuro, have been made with Navy PB4-51 Patrol Bombers. At Kusaie it was necessary

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to use jet assisted take off because of limited space in the harbor. The VP-2 Commander asked Lieutenant Colonel Barney to keep flights to Kusaie at a minimum, preferably for emergencies only, because of the poor landing and take off facilities there. However, an additional requirement was placed upon the VP-2 Squadron Commander and this problem was finally solved by a demand for flights to Kusaie by Joint Task Force 132.⁹ The officers and airmen of the VP-2 Squadron have been extremely helpful and cooperative in the planning and execution of these flights.

Brigadier General Frederic E. Glantzberg, USAF, Commander of Task Group 132.4, inspected the installations at Ponape and Kusaie and the Weather Central at Eniwetok. On 2 October he sent a letter to Colonel Roy W. Nelson Jr., USAF, Commander of Test Services Unit 132.4.3, congratulating him on the ". . . state of readiness of all three stations . . .",¹⁰ and expressing his appreciation to all concerned. Colonel Nelson indorsed the letter to Lieutenant Colonel Barney commending him for his successful establishment of the outlying weather detachments.¹¹

On 26 September this headquarters received from Task Group 132.4 the authority to issue Special Orders, Letter Orders, and Personnel Actions Memorandums.¹²

On 6 October Lieutenant Colonel Girardo, Commander Joint Task Force Weather Central, arrived from Eniwetok to confer with Colonel Nelson, Lieutenant Colonel Barney, and Lieutenant Colonel Fred C. Simpson, USAF, Commander Weather Reconnaissance Element 132.4.3.1. They discussed the

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requirements for weather reconnaissance flights by Colonel Simpson's
EM at and the procedures to be used in disseminating weather data
from the four outlying islands and what final request to make on MANAM
to AACJ Manual 105-2, Part 8.

Pertaining to the MANAM of AACJ Manual 105-2, Part 8 and addition
to the Pacific Weather Handbook relating to weather data from the four
outlying islands the following had occurred: On 18 September a message
was sent by Lieutenant Colonel Barney to 2143rd Air Weather Group, Tokyo,
Japan stating that this data was available for use by detachments of the
2143rd Wing. The reply to this message was MANAM 75 JPNZ committing the
Naval Aerological Station at Kwajalein to edit and compile the collect-
ive of the meteorological data from the four weather islands. At this
time, the Naval Aerological Station was under an additional operational
demand and working overtime to meet this demand. This, plus the fact
that the Communications Center at Kwajalein was merely an intercept
station, with Eniwetok being network control for the collection of this
data, and also the fact that the Naval Aerological Station at Kwajalein
was not a part of Task Group 132.4, caused a new decision to be made.
After a check with the Commander Test Services Unit 132.4.3, Communica-
tions Officer Task Group 132.4, Commander 1960th AACJ Squadron, and
Commander Naval Aerological Station at Kwajalein it was determined that
Joint Task Force Weather Central was the most feasible location to edit
and compile the collective. Decision was made and a request to Commander
21-3rd Wing was sent to correct MANAM 75 JPNZ. Correction requested was
substitution of ABB (Eniwetok) for NWA (Kwajalein). The 2143rd Wing
Commander complied and MANAM 80 JPNZ was issued making the substitutions

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was requested. On 8 October, however, at the meeting with Lieutenant Colonel Girardo it was learned that there would be a duplication of everything except personnel when the Weather Central was moved from Aniwetok to a new operating location. The personnel of the Weather Central would be limited to approximately fifty percent of its authorized strength. The additional workload of editing and compiling the collective at that time would be too great a burden. To overcome this problem a third message was sent to 2143rd Wing requesting another change to the original MANAM 75 JPNZ. The 2143rd Wing Commander complied with the request and MANAM 83 JPNZ was issued which placed the task of editing and compiling of the data from the weather islands on the Naval Aerological Station at Kwajalein. A request for augmentation of the Naval Aerological Station for this task would be in order and is recommended for future operations of this type.



On 9 October all personnel of Task Element 132.4.3.2 were informed by a letter that the address for official and personal mail had been changed to: Rank, Name, AFON, Organization, Navy Co. 824, Box 35, c/o FPO, San Francisco California for Headquarters and four outlying islands.

All barometers of Task Element 132.4.3.2 had to be calibrated. The observers of the Headquarters Checking Section handcarried two precision aneroid barometers from Finken Air Force Base to be used for checking detachment barometers. It was feared that the flight had affected them in such a way as to make them unfit for checking purposes so they were left at Hickam Air Force Base with the 57th Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron, Medium, Weather, to be checked for possible error.

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~~Attachment 57th~~ departed Hickam before the barometers had been checked so it was agreed that the 57th would have someone deliver the barometers to this headquarters at Kwajalein when they were checked. Upon delivery here it was found that the barometers were unfit for use because of an excessive amount of error. The 57th placed a man on TDY to this headquarters and he checked the barometers at all detachments using the 57th's aneroids. Resupply trips were used as a means of getting to the detachments to calibrate the barometers. This was accomplished by 1 October.

On 18 September a letter was sent from this headquarters to the detachments on disposition of weather records. The purpose of this letter was to assure that weather records submitted would be for certain regulated periods to avoid confusion. In checking surface weather records it was noted that observers were making excessive amounts of errors. The exact reasons for this were not entirely explainable but two seemed to be gross carelessness and confusion on how to make certain entries. The checking was very thorough and chief observers at all detachments were sent letters explaining the causes and recommended corrections for their poor entries on WGAN forms. By 1 October this practice of sending information letters to each detachment had resulted in a marked improvement in the observers' work. Although the records were checked during the Training Period at Tinker Air Force Base by 6th Weather Squadron, the great number of records checked there prevented checking from being any more thorough than spot checking most of the time. If the Task Element record checkers had checked records at Tinker and checked them as thoroughly as they have been checked here the greatest amount of errors

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would have been eliminated before departure for the forward area. The rawinsonde runs that have been checked here show no excessive amounts of errors and no problem has been presented there. One problem plaguing both rawinsonde and observer checking sections has been erroneous time entries. Some stations were using 165th meridian time and entering 180th on their forms, while some were using 180th meridian time and entering 165th on their forms. All stations should have been using and entering on their headings 180th meridian (Mike) time, in accordance with Operational Order, 6th Weather Squadron, dated 28 July, but apparently this was not understood by all personnel.

The Headquarters Checking Section started keeping climatological records of all weather data received as of 1 October. These record forms constituted a great bulk and consequently were left at Tinker Air Force Base to be forwarded by mail, rather than be carried TAF by shipment 697-41. The forms were not quick in arriving so a message was sent requesting they be sent as soon as possible. This message was sent about 5 October and forms arrived on 13 October. If the forms had not arrived soon it would have taken considerable time to fill out such a backlog. To save time in future operations of this type these documentary record forms should be carried TAF or mailed previous to departure of shipment ¹⁷ to the appropriate Post Office.

PERSONNEL

Lieutenant Colonel William S. Barney, USAF, Commanding Officer 6th Weather Squadron was appointed Commanding Officer of Weather Reporting Element 132-3.2, Provisional on 11 September. On the same date Major ¹⁸

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James E. Carpenter was relieved of the duty of Commanding Officer of
the Tank Element and appointed Deputy Commanding Officer.¹⁹

During the LST voyage S/Sgt John A. Bollinger, USAF, assigned to this element as a cook, was reported ill and sent to Kwajalein for treatment. Upon his arrival at Kwajalein it was found that he was not ill so he waited there for the headquarters increment to arrive and reassign him.

On 17 September A/1C William K. Tank, USAF, assigned to this element as a cook, had to be evacuated from his duty station at Kusaie and brought to Kwajalein for an Appendectomy. Seven hours after notification of the diagnosis at Kusaie the Appendectomy was performed, revealing that it had been an acute, gangrenous infection. The efficient operation of Lieutenant White, USN, Commander of the PBM-5A evacuation plane, and the Naval Station Hospital at Kwajalein made such swift service possible.

S/Sgt Bollinger was assigned to Kusaie as a replacement for A/1C Tank. The hospital at Kwajalein released A/1C Tank on 25 September and on 11 October he proceeded to Bikini for light duty there.

On 9 September S/Sgt Henry V. Moore, USAF, a ravinsonde operator at Majuro was evacuated to Kwajalein for medical treatment and a few days later was sent to Tripler Hospital in Hawaii for further treatment of a kidney ailment. A/1C Michael J. Benetz, USAF, a ravinsonde operator in Headquarters Checking Section, was sent to Majuro as a replacement for S/Sgt Moore. On 4 October S/Sgt Moore, after being released from Tripler Hospital, was returned to duty at Majuro and A/1C Benetz was returned to duty in the checking section.

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When S/sgt Moore was evacuated and sent to Tripler it was not anticipated that he would be able to return to duty as soon as he did, and a request for an additional rawinsonde operator was sent to the 6th Weather Squadron. When S/sgt Moore returned Lieutenant Colonel Barney did not nullify his request for an additional operator. He decided it would be better to have another operator sent because utilization of another was no problem and it would help in the event of future shortages of operators. The additional operator arrived on 10 October²¹ Eight days elapsed from his date of departure from Tinker Air Force Base until his arrival here. On 14 October he was sent to Kusaie and another operator returned from Kusaie. The operator brought from Kusaie has been utilized in the Headquarters Checking Section since his arrival here on 14 October.

The foregoing are excellent examples of the personnel problems that have been encountered by this headquarters during the time the Task Element has been in the forward area. In all cases shuffling of personnel alleviated the shortages. However, it was noted that personnel shortages occurred in AFSCs that were on hand here for replacement. Had a shortage occurred in an AFSC not available here for replacement there would have been no way to alleviate the situation and the result would have been an under strength detachment. It was fortunate that replacement of personnel could be made from Headquarters personnel at a time when the work load was not heavy on their sections.

On 18 September Major Carpentier was made certifying officer of this Task Element by vocal order of the Commanding General of Task Group 132.4. This was done for the purpose of certifying WPOs for Task Element

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Personnel, written confirmation orders were published on 23 September. Major Carpenter was appointed Class "A" Agent to 1st Lieutenant R. L. Collins, USA, Finance Officer of Task Group 132.4. The purpose of this appointment was to authorize Major Carpenter to pay cash or checks to officers and airmen of Task Element 132.4.3.2.

SUPPLY

Geno O. Carbow, A/2C, USAF, Senior Organizational Supply Specialist issued organizational clothing and equipment to personnel of shipment 6998 at Tinker Air Force Base during the period prior to his departure with shipment 6998-EI on 11 September.

Wayne L. Neal, T/Sgt, USAF, Supply Supervisor, could not procure office furniture for this headquarters prior to its arrival because he was not authorized to open a supply account. An officer had to be designated to open a supply account. He could not accomplish this part of the mission he had been sent ahead to do, that of setting up the headquarters. He could not have anything issued to this headquarters until an officer arrived so many items were hard to obtain. However, T/Sgt Neal had this headquarters completely equipped by 17 September, two days after its arrival. The one thing which was difficult to obtain was a sufficient number of typewriters. The situation was eased by obtaining two from WREP-2 and WREP-3 to supplement the one obtained through normal supply channels here.

By about 20 September all detachments had submitted long lists of requested supplies. Because the detachments are self sufficient units the requests submitted were composed of numerous items which a w other detach-

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extent of comparable size at a military installation would never require. Many of the requested items were not available at Kwajalein.

This headquarters used the 57th Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron's M/R account. The 57th's Technical Supply Officer gave T/agt Neal and A/2C Curbow authority to draw expendable items from his account.

Many items had to be drawn from Naval Supply here at Kwajalein because Base Supply had a very limited stock of material and no stock of meteorological supplies. Proper procedure was to check first on availability of items at Base Supply and then, if necessary, stub requisition from Naval Supply.

Naval Supply also had no stock of many items such as reefer parts, vehicle parts, and meteorological equipment. All of these items had to be requisitioned from either Hickam Air Force Base or Sacramento Air Materiel Area.

One supply man went on each flight to the outlying islands. At each location the supply man on the flight issued class "I" khaki uniforms and shoes to all personnel as well as conferring with detachment commanders on their needs.

The class "I" uniforms and shoes mentioned above were procured from Base Supply at Kwajalein, and accountability dropped by entering the issue on each man's Form 191. Two uniforms and one pair of service shoes was procured for and issued to each individual.

The main problems encountered by the supply personnel of the Task Element headquarters were:

1. Non-availability of material at Base Supply or Naval Supply.
2. Failure of Detachment Commanders to send in proper description of the supplies requested. Many items were requested without giving

stock numbers and only a vague description of the item wanted.

3. Detachment Commanders requested many items which were difficult or impossible to obtain. Many of the items requested could have been improvised, thus easing the burden on supply personnel.

By about 5 October the supply situation had eased in that requests from detachments were smaller and easier to handle.²⁴

Because flights to the islands were almost invariably scheduled for early morning take off, supplies had to be procured the day before the flight and stored overnight for loading in the morning, or loaded the day before the flight. The supplies were picked up the day or several days before the flight, stored in two small locked rooms in this headquarters, and transported to and loaded aboard the plane. These supplies consisted of Post Exchange goods, motion picture films, clothing, medical supplies, construction materials, and housekeeping items requested by the detachments. All duties performed in connection with procurement, storage, and transportation of these supplies were by Headquarters supply personnel.

On about 6 October, General Glantzberg forwarded a letter to the High Commissioner for the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands requesting his concurrence in the exchange of detachments' perishable supplies and fuel oil products for labor and services provided the detachments by Trust Territory Personnel.²⁵ As of 15 October, response to this request had not arrived at this headquarters.
