The Advisory Committee for Biology and Medicine met in Washington on September 21 and 22, and at that time discussed plans for their future meetings. In view of the many changes at the Brookhaven National Laboratory since the Committee visited there in December, 1952, the members thought that it would be well to once again visit the Laboratory to visit the present facilities and laboratories and to discuss the trend of the research programs.
