On Monday, May 14th, we plan to have an all day meeting dealing with Plutonium from the health aspects. The meeting will start at 9 a.m. in the usual meeting room.

There is a question in the minds of some of those engaged in actual health protection as to whether the experiments done, being done, or planned are answering or will answer the questions they feel should be answered. Consequently, I ask that Drs. Wirth, Nickson, Cantril, and Hempelman send in a letter stating the practical problems that they want the experimentalists to solve. Such letters should then be circulated to those doing the experimental work. Some of you may have to write to Colonel Warren; if so, I hope that he will circulate the requests, if not the whole letter.

By this letter I am asking Drs. Cole, Hamilton, and Nickson to please have the information they and their associates have accumulated to date in clear tabular form for easy presentation, interpretation, and comparison. This should include information regarding experience with personnel as well as with animals.

Colonel Warren is cordially asked to take part in this meeting with his staff and such others as he knows of who may be working with plutonium. He has already informally agreed to this meeting being one with complete coverage of this problem.

No other meeting of the Health Division will take place except for the information meeting of the project council on Tuesday. Section chiefs, group leaders, and regular personnel engaged on this problem, should attend the meeting---at the discretion of the section chiefs.
