SUBJECT: MARCH MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON BIOLOGY AND MEDICINE

Reference our earlier telephone conversation and your memo attached. As I indicated, the Commission expressed a desire to meet with the ACEM prior to the 202 hearings. Recognizing that this would require a special meeting, and special preparation, it does not appear to me that items for consideration are of sufficient urgency to justify this action. I have, therefore, recommended to the Commission, and they have accepted, that a special meeting not be called, but that definite plans be made now for the Commission to meet with the Committee at its regularly scheduled meeting in March.

I understand this meeting is now scheduled to be held in Oak Ridge. It is requested that you arrange with the Committee for the meeting (at least the first day) be held in Washington and that an agreed agenda be developed for discussion with the Commission. The agenda should include rather specific items, but should consist of items of a policy nature. I would like to go over these items with you, after which it will be necessary to develop specific information necessary to prepare the Commissioners for such meeting.
