SUBJECT: NEXT JOINT SESSION OF G.A.C. WITH A.C.B.M.

Dr. John Bugher has suggested that I communicate with you for any amplification of his suggested topics for the next joint session of the General Advisory Committee with the Advisory Committee for Biology & Medicine, which session now is scheduled to be held in Washington in period of October 25 through 27. More specifically, it would be held sometime in period from early afternoon of October 25 to the end of business on October 26, depending on your views, because the remaining time now is to be devoted to other matters.

Although it is not yet decided just how much time might be allotted for the session, Dr. Bugher's proposed topics are the national impact of nuclear war, civil defense, and research in reactor safety.

At the forthcoming GAC meeting, to be held at the Livermore Laboratory on July 12 through 14, the Committee will decide its agenda for its October meeting. Do you have any comments at this time to furnish me or Chairman Hafstad for GAC consideration?
