Dear Doctor Hodges:

On behalf of the Trustees and staff of The Jackson Laboratory, I am happy to invite the Advisory Committee for Biology and Medicine, U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, to hold one of its regular bimonthly meetings at the Laboratory for the purpose, among others, of reviewing the research projects being supported at the Laboratory by the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission.

If you are in favor of this meeting, as we all hope you will be, we shall have to settle on an exact date and an agenda.

With respect to date, these comments may be helpful:

May 14 - 15, 1965. This date is possible, but the larger hotels, motels, and restaurants will not yet be open for the 1965 season, but many smaller ones will be in operation.

June 11 - 12, 1965. This date is eminently desirable. Most hotels, etc., will be open and pre-season rates will still be in effect. The Laboratory's own summer programs will not yet be in full swing and staff members will have fewer distractions.

July 9 - 10, 1965. Possible, but the meeting will come on top of the full schedule of the student research training program of the Laboratory. All hotels, etc., open, but prices at peak.

August 13 - 14, 1965. Impossible. Short Course in Medical Genetics will be in progress with 75 professors of medicine on hand. Administration busy preparing for meeting of Laboratory's Trustees.

September 10 - 11, 1965. Possible and almost as desirable as June. All hotels, etc., open. Late season rates. All summer students and visiting investigators will have departed.
