AEC ADVISORY COMMITTEES

In August 1971 Dr. Schlesinger requested a complete review of all AEC Advisory Committees and on November 3 the Commission approved the discontinuance of the following committees:

Advisory Committee on Isotope and Radiation Development
Advisory Committee for Plowshare
Advisory Committee for Nuclear Cross Sections
Advisory Committee for Mathematics & Computer Sciences Research
Advisory Committee on Technical Information
Technical Information Panel

Following the Commission action noted above, the Division of Reactor Development and Technology reexamined the need for the Advisory Committee on Reactor Physics and on its own initiative recommended that it be discontinued.

Subsequent to the above action and shortly after your appointment to the Commission, the Commission requested that the following committees be again reexamined by staff as to their need. These committees included:

Advisory Committee on Biology and Medicine
High Energy Physics Advisory Panel
Advisory Committee on Controlled Thermonuclear Research
Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes
Advisory Committee on Nuclear Materials Safeguards

As you know, at Policy Session 87 on February 1, 1973 the Commission specifically approved the continuation of all Advisory Committees listed in SECY-2899 with the exception of the Advisory Committee on Biology and Medicine.
