DECISION ON AEC 156

ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON BIOLOGY AND MEDICINE -  
REPORT ON OCTOBER MEETING AT HANFORD

Note by the Secretary

At Meeting 212 on October 27, 1948; the Commission considered AEC 156, together with a supplementary report (AEC 156/1) on staff action taken after the meeting of the Advisory Committee.

The Commission took the following action:

a. Approved the following resolution:

"BE IT RESOLVED, that the Atomic Energy Commission express its appreciation to the Advisory Committee for Biology and Medicine for their advice and aid in overcoming the numerous problems that arise in the fields of health and biology as related to atomic energy and in advancing the peaceful utilization of this new scientific field."

b. Requested that this resolution be transmitted to the Chairman of the Advisory Committee for Biology and Medicine by means of a letter such as that attached to AEC 156.
