Dear Dr. Gregg:

I want to extend to you and the Committee an invitation to visit the new Radiological Laboratory building on the San Francisco campus of the University of California, on or about January 11th or 12th. I have been informed that the Advisory Committee on Biology and Medicine is contemplating meeting in the Bay area on Friday, January 11th and Saturday, January 12th.

As you know, the building has been completed and the equipment is being installed. The synchrotron has already produced x-rays on a trial basis, but is not yet in its finished form in the building. It will be possible however, by January 10th to give you and your Committee a very good idea of the finished state of the building and equipment.

I know that you and the Committee will be extremely busy during your visit out here and we will therefore be happy to adjust our time to yours and hope that you can let us know in advance what time you will be able to come to visit us.

The University has not encouraged official openings or formal openings of various buildings and so we have not arranged any special formal opening. It could well be that the occasion of your visit might be considered as the official opening of the building.

I am addressing this letter to you as Chairman, with a copy to Dr. Warren. If you feel that you and the Committee can make this visit to San Francisco, I will be more than happy to send letters of invitation to each member of your Committee.
