Reference is made to your memorandum of February 7, 1955, subject as above, symbol BM:JCB, with regard to the acceptance of our invitation for the Advisory Committee to meet in Oak Ridge. The dates you suggested of May 6 and 7, 1955, are quite agreeable to ourselves and our contractors. Within the time available, it is hoped we can review for the Committee many of the significant advances in biomedical research at Oak Ridge.

In connection with this forthcoming meeting, it was indicated during the UT-AEC Program review in Washington on January 27, that one or more members of the Committee may visit at UT-AEC a day or so in advance of the formal meeting on May 6. We hope this can be accomplished. If not, we will be prepared to include a short discussion of the UT-AEC Agricultural Research Program within the morning agenda of May 6.

Our present planning for the Advisory Committee meeting includes the following tentative program: The morning session on Friday, May 6, is scheduled for 8:30 A.M. in the Medical Division conference room of the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies. The ORINS Medical Staff will be prepared to present significant aspects of their progress and planning in the cancer research program. At 11:30 A.M. the group will leave for the Oak Ridge National Laboratory where the Committee will be guests of ORNL for a luncheon at the X-10 Cafeteria. The afternoon session will be held at X-10, and will cover the Program 6000 activities of the Laboratory.

On May 7, the Committee is invited to meet for its executive session in the conference room of the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies, located in the Institute's central administration building. We will make arrangements for transportation from this building for those who desire to leave at the end of the day.
