The minutes on the meeting of the Ad Hoc Committee on Human Radiobiology of August 22, 1973, discussed the ethics of the program and development of consent forms. I would suggest that the consent forms and the general procedures of the study be reviewed by the Human Studies Committee of LASL and UNM. I presume this can be done as part of the legal review, but it should entail some additional review of the procedures, experimental protocols, etc. I would think their review should just be on a general procedural basis so we can assure ourselves that the committees are aware of and approve the proposed procedures.

Dr. Harry Whipple was the former chairman of our Human Studies group at LASL. Since his retirement I have not had a replacement, but tentatively expect to have Dr. Robert Grier assume the responsibility when he reports to work on September 17.
