JULY, 1962

1. An investigation composed mostly of literature review and private communications was conducted regarding the variation of sodium levels in man. It was concluded from the information obtained that a variation of 10% or less would be expected in the body sodium levels among healthy workers.
2. Several ideas of an operating nature, e.g., bioassay of new hires, sample scheduling, standardized sample volume, etc. were submitted for consideration.
3. The investigation of plutonium in the human body was initiated as a broad study.
4. Continued in the capacity of RPO representative to the HLO A-O-V panel.
