MEDICAL RESEARCH COMMITTEE

The third meeting of the Medical Research Committee of the Hospital and the University of California was called to order by the Chairman, Dr. John Manley, at 4:00 p.m., July 13, 1950, in the conference room of the hospital. Those present were: Dr. John Manley, Chairman, Dr. Elizabeth Graves, Dr. Thomas L. Shipman, Dr. William Hawley, Dr. Clarence Lushbaugh, and Dr. James Brennan was present representing Dr. Wright Langham and Dr. Robert E. Carter. Dr. William Natoli was present as a guest of the Committee.

The minutes of the previous meeting were not read by mutual consent of the members present.

Dr. Graves reported that Dr. Cogan's work on radiation cataracts had commenced and some rabbits were already in the process of being exposed.

Dr. Manley suggested that the discussion of the dental research program be put off until a later meeting.

Dr. William Natoli then presented the program concerning placental localization by the use of radioactive substances, which is also covered in memorandum dated June 23, 1950, from Dr. Natoli to Dr. Eric Hausner, copies of which have been sent to all members of the Committee. During the course of the discussion, Dr. Lushbaugh stated that the hospital was to have two technicians of their own paid from hospital funds which were for the use of hospital personnel doing research. In addition, counting equipment was to be bought from the hospital fixed equipment fund. Animals for use in this experiment were to be provided by the University of California. The probe-type counter mentioned in Dr. Natoli's memorandum is to be purchased by the University of California, inasmuch as this equipment would be useful to the University Group as well as for Dr. Natoli's research.

The Committee felt that Dr. Natoli's project had merit and that he should be permitted to carry the project forward.
