Meeting times were changed to every other Monday at 3:30 pm.
(Next meeting is on June 7, 1976.)

A rough draft of a memo from Helland, Kittell, Lundy, Swenson, and van der Beken to E. A. Knapp was discussed. Helland was the only one of the five authors present. Knapp asked if money in the new grant should be directed toward personnel instead of capital equipment or materials. Helland responded with a definite yes. Bradbury pointed out the fact that LAMFF may start its own computer center, and asked that we stay abreast of these developments. Knapp emphasized that there is essentially no hope of our getting a PDP-11/70, so we'll have to solve our problems in other ways. He also said it was unlikely that we could link to the MP-3 computer before the beam tuning is finished (approx. six months from now).

Knapp asked if we could use operator-programmer-techs to work on the system. He said we should have someone here all the time, who knows the system and can solve the problems as they come up. The committee agreed that such persons would be valuable to the project. Knapp said he would try to divert funds from "Materials and Services" to "Personnel" on the NCI Grant. Helland pointed out that, prior to the hiring of these operators, he can solve computer problems from home during off hours, if experimenters will only call him.
