SUBJECT: Call for Patients for Pion Radiotherapy

This is a reminder to let you know that we will be starting a pion treatment cycle on May 17, 1979, and still have openings if any of you have suitable cases. Our priorities for case accession are as follows:

1. Advanced, localized tumors of the rectum and rectosigmoid (with metastases not past the pelvis)
2. Malignant gliomas (Astrocytoma III or IV)
3. Advanced, localized tumors of the head and neck (oral cavity, nasopharynx, hypopharynx, and oropharynx)
4. Localized tumors of the pancreas (metastases not past the regional nodes)
5. Advanced, localized tumors of the prostate (metastases not past the pelvis)
6. Advanced, localized tumors of the urinary bladder (metastases not past the pelvis)
7. Advanced, localized tumors of the larynx

We can also accept tumors of the superior sulcus, esophagus, stomach and uterine cervix, as those are sites we eventually want to treat in randomized studies.
