
Dear Dr. Lawrence:

In reference to the attached rough draft I have checked with Mr. Reynolds and he informed me that he has called Jim Miller on the phone regarding this and in essence telling Mr. Miller verbally that in his opinion and in all probability that the AEC would give in the neighborhood of \$45,000 to help equip the new Metabolic Unit. However, at this time he did not want to put this in writing since he had nothing in writing from Harold Fidler who in turn had nothing in writing from Chicago. As a matter of fact, I understand a letter has been sent from Wally through Harold telling the AEC that unless they, the AEC, had any objections that the Radiation Laboratory was going to proceed on this basis of helping to equip the Unit. They are waiting to hear from the AEC as to whether or not there are any objections or that there is agreement. This answer, to the best of my knowledge up to this writing, has not been received.

I have also made a preliminary check as to whether or not actual cash had been received within the University from the Donner people, that is \$50,000. The preliminary check did not affirm this. I will try again. In view of the Reynold's development I am wondering if the attached rough draft would then be in order to President Sproul, which I have revised.
