The purpose of this memorandum is to give you a statement of the three contracts we have which require assistance in order to keep up their research programs with a sufficient supply of radio-isotopes for which they had not budgeted as you know. The contractors and amounts needed are:

University of Rochester, W-7401-eng-49	\$ 5,000
Western Reserve University, W-31-109-eng-78	5,800
New York University, AT-30-1-GEN-328	11,000.

The statement on New York University was contained in a memorandum dated July 27 enclosed with mine of August 9 to you. The Western Reserve amount was mentioned in my memorandum of September 11 which also referred to the New Brunswick requirement of \$750 that you are covering without purchase orders. You may consider the figure as serving informational purposes.

To complete the information furnished you on the isotope program, there are the following two items:

1. The representative for Kellex listed in the September 11 memorandum as Dr. "Bair" should be Dr. Bain.
2. The Brookhaven National Laboratory has appointed Mr. Paul Colsmann as an alternate to Dr. Marvin Fox. Mr. Colsmann will handle matters of a routine nature.

R. Jones will advise us when these figures are verified. NYU figures very questionable now.
