Subject: APPROVAL OF USE OF P 32 IN HUMANS

Dear Dr. Evans:

This office is pleased to reply to your letter of March 11, 1948, signed by Herman M. Nachman, in which it was requested that the Atomic Energy Commission approve the use in humans of P 32 still on hand. The P 32 available for such use is understood to have been obtained under Approval No. 989.

We are pleased to approve your request for an opportunity to use the P 32 in humans. The Subcommittee on Human Applications has stipulated, however, that this approval is contingent upon the condition that no more than 500 microcuries will be administered to any one patient within a period of six months. In order that our files may be complete, we shall appreciate a letter from you to indicate that you accept this condition.


