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TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD

5 P01 CA16127-05

This award reflects amounts negotiated between representatives of the National Cancer Institute and Mrs. Wilson on June 12, 1978.

Funds approved for to-be-hired personnel may not be used for any other purpose without the prior approval of the National Cancer Institute.

Included in this award is a carryover of \$100,000 in equipment funds from the 04 year for the partial purchase of a CAT Scanner. If the actual direct cost balance from the 04 year is less, authorization for this will be reduced accordingly.

Funds approved for the CAT Scanner (\$200,000) may not be used for any other purpose without the prior approval of the National Cancer Institute.

In the absence of Hospitalization Negotiation Agreements, charges consistent with those charged other patients at Bernalillo County Medical Center, Lovelace-Bataan Medical Center and Veterans Administration Hospital-Albuquerque may be made to this grant for research patient care costs.

Grant funds may be used only for research using protocols that have been reviewed and approved in accordance with the grantee's Assurance accepted by the National Institutes of Health.

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Even if certain aspects of the research are carried out in other institutions, the grantee institution will be responsible for the initial and continuing review of those parts of the study. This review, however, may be carried out in cooperation with appropriate committees or groups within the other institutions.

Funds approved for patient care costs may not be used for any other purpose without the prior approval of the National Cancer Institute.

If any of the three hospitals providing services to patients participation in this research program receive \$25,000 or more from this grant, a research care negotiation agreement must be established with DHEW.

This award is made with the understanding that a signed, written agreement approved by the National Cancer Institute, will be executed within 90 days of the issuance date of this award between the University of New Mexico and the University of California System for research to be conducted at the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory, Los Alamos, New Mexico. Unless such an acceptable agreement is made by that time, the current award will be subject to renegotiation.

Funds for research to be conducted at LASL have been included in the Contractural or Third Party Costs budget category and have been awarded as follows:

Reimbursements for research performed at LASL shall be made on the basis of approved certified vouchers signed by the principal investigator and approved by an administrative official of the grantee institution.

No indirect costs may be claimed by the University of New Mexico for research conducted at the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory. The indirect costs at the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory are included as a direct cost in this award and are based on the approved budget using the negotiated rate available at the time of award. Actual indirect costs claimed must be based on actual direct cost expenditures. Funds awarded for indirect costs (Administrative Services) may not be used for any other purpose without the prior approval of the National Cancer Institute and no additional funds will be awarded for this purpose. Funds may be rebudgeted into (but not out of) the Administrative Services cost category.

The University of New Mexico, in accordance with its institutional rebudgeting policies, may rebudget funds within the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory or within the University of New Mexico budget, but prior National Cancer Institute approval is necessary for rebudgeting these two accounts.
