Dear Sir:

The question has been raised as to how employees terminated by Clinton Laboratories are to get in contact with the prime contractor in the event that Clinton Laboratories ceases to exist as such. It is recognized that it might be highly desirable for such a contact to be made promptly if, in the opinion of the employee, working conditions on this plant shall have resulted in ill health.

In our telephone conversation several days ago, you suggested that terminated employees be notified to write to Clinton Laboratories, c/o U. S. Engineer Office, Manhattan District, P. O. Box E, Oak Ridge, Tenn. if they wish to contact the organization responsible for Clinton Laboratories' contract after the dissolution of Clinton Laboratories.

Mr. Harrell, for the University of Chicago, has agreed to this arrangement on condition that you write him indicating that this arrangement is satisfactory to you and will result in correspondence being promptly brought to the attention of University authorities. Will you please write such a letter to Mr. Harrell, sending copies to Mr. Compton and to me.
