Although you have not had an opportunity to read some of the writings of the Laboratory Director on the functions of the Research Program Leader, it is clear that the work which is contemplated by Honstead and Nelson involving two different Sections should be coordinated by the Research Program Leader approach. It is important that the responsibility for the planning and execution of this program be assigned to one person. For the purposes of the program that we are now envisioning, this responsibility should be assigned to the Environmental Studies and Evaluation Section and specifically, therefore, the Research Program Leader should be John Honstead.

Understanding the advantages of this approach is extremely important. Under different circumstances, where the end purpose of the study is something other than exposure mechanisms, such a joint program could easily be under the leadership of someone in the Dosimetry Studies and Evaluation Section. If we are successful, I am certain that this example will turn out to be a reality in the foreseeable future.
