SUBJECT: Your memo of December 21, 1972 calling for immediate action on the Rochester cases.

1. I noted with great pleasure the immediate and decisive response from Dr. Rundo about collection and analysis of excreta.
2. We may get some ideas about containers and transport for excreta from:
 - a) Our planned (and aborted) metabolic study of case 03-203 which was to be done by collection of excreta at her home. In August, 1971, I asked Al Keane to see that containers and boxes were available to proceed as he had done previously (1967) in a collection-at-home study on case 01-520. I believe he did this with the help of D. Kuchta.
 - b) Our study at Manteno in June, 1970 ([REDACTED]). We provided containers and detailed instructions, but delivered and picked up the containers by auto, not by public transport.
3. I don't know when we can have the meeting before your "as soon as possible" letter to Rochester. Dr. Rundo will also be on "vacation", but may come in to do a measurement of body radio-activity for a special case.
4. How about routinely sending copies of memos about CHR studies to all CHR group leaders? Hopefully, they can recognize when their participation is expected.
