We have located an additional patient for you, who was on your list. Inasmuch as all of the specimen containers were used by we have no means of forwarding the additional specimens. Because of the circumstances which collection involves, we are making arrangements for collection of these in pyrex jars to which will be added 10 cc of formalin per specimen. We will also forward a specimen of formalin for analysis. If you feel that special technique of collection is necessary for a completely accurate analysis please advise us.

Also, we are interested in the possible findings related to this series of studies and would appreciate any information you will be able to give us as soon as they are completed.

Do you wish more patients if we are able to locate them? As is rather typical, many of these patients have either moved away, stopped clinic attendance temporarily, or have had a fatal outcome unknown to us. However, as in this case, contact may be made and the collection of specimens easily arranged for, we will be glad to make these collections for you if this will help complete your information on this rather crucial subject.
