We received the wire from Dr. Howland saying that approval had not been authorized by the Isotope Sub-Committee. I advised Miss Pillion of the unfavorable action of the Committee on Human Applications regarding Dr. Howland's request for radiogold for a constituent with heart disease. I also advised her of the relationship of the Sub-Committee to the Isotopes Division and of the latter to the Division of Biology and Medicine and the Division of Research. She will contact, I am sure, Dr. Aebersold.
