- a/ NO NEW ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT OF ANY KIND, OR MECHANICAL GUY WIRES, CAN BE INTRODUCED ANYWHERE WITHIN THE TEST AREA OR INSIDE SHELTERS AFTER 1200 JULY 11. THESE REHEARSALS ARE PRIMARILY TO DETECT PICK-UP AND INTERFERENCE TROUBLES AND THE INTRODUCTION OF A SINGLE NEW PIECE OF EQUIPMENT MAY VITIATE (FOBAR) THE WORK OF MANY OTHERS. GROUP AND SECTION LEADERS ARE HELD RESPONSIBLE TO SEE THAT ALL TEAMS CONFORM TO THIS RULE.
- b/ All out of test area and in shelters at -1 hour.
Films developed before 0800 on the following day.
Individual tests or inter-group cooperating tests can follow the analyses of records up to -4 hours of the next shot.
- c/ The real full dress rehearsal.
Start out of area -2-1/2 hours.
In shelters or at Base Camp at -2 hours.
Complete guarding system, and check-up at -1-3/4 hours. Don't close your car windows. Don't ride with your radio turned on!
Test of communications, local, remote, and to plane.
Rehearsal of medical group preparations 0010 the following day
Records developed by noon the following day.
