1. Comdr. N. E. Bradbury, Group X-6, has very generously agreed to supply assistance on explosives for both the Trinity test and prior experimental work. All requests for such assistance should be addressed to Comdr. Bradbury with a copy to Lt. W. F. Schaffer, J. H. Williams and K. Bainbridge.

2. If men in addition to T/4 Benjamin are required at Trinity, Comdr. Bradbury has agreed to supply suitable personnel if sufficient warning is given and if transportation is arranged for them through John Williams' office.

3. In order to prepare suitable magazines at Trinity and conform to the requirements of the Safety Committee, I need not later than Monday, March 26, to have estimates, particularly from Hanley, Mack and Segre, of future schedules of test shots at Trinity, nature and amounts of explosives, etc., so that there will be sufficient information to define the size and type of magazines.
