Subject: Addition No. 5 to March 24, 1945 Project TR Circular

1. TRANSPORT OF H.E. - In order to conform to the I.C.C. and military laws regarding the transport of H.E. in any form, it is necessary to give Mr. Harry Allen a minimum of two days warning to set up the convoy and to arrange for cars and trucks. It is illegal to transport H.E. and detonators in the same vehicle, so that a separate vehicle is required for detonators and another vehicle for H.E. In addition, an escort car must be included, as the law requires that if the group stops for lunch in a town, the H.E. must be left at some distance, defined by law, outside the town, and the escort car provides for transportation to and from the town.

In view of all these requirements which must be met, it is to the advantage of everyone to pool their H.E. shipments. All of those contemplating shipments in the near future should notify Mr. Allen by noon Wednesday April 18 of any future shipments of H.E. to Trinity. Please send copies of your memorandum to J. H. Williams and K. T. Bainbridge.
