Security Measures at Omega

1. I have discussed with Dr. Bacher the procedure outlined by you for the guarding of Omega and he and I concur with your proposals. Additional security measures will be taken by the technical personnel itself in connection with the valuable material and secret experiments undertaken.
2. Both Mr. Bacher and I feel that it would be desirable to allow passage up and down Los Alamos canyon for all who have permanent passes to the post. The reason for this is that the upper part of Los Alamos canyon and the area south of the post are already restricted and that to take Los Alamos Canyon out of circulation would be an undesirable further limitation on walks and rides.


