MEMORANDUM FOR J. R. OPPENHEIMER:

It has been brought to my attention that Dr. E. Segre published, in the July 1943, issue of "Scientific Monthly", an article entitled "Artificial Radio-activity and the Completion of the Periodic System of the Elements". This article was apparently published while Segre was still an active member of the Physics Department at U.C., and I note that publication took place prior to the issuance of a Manhattan District security directive enjoining all concerned to secure the approval of the District Engineer before publishing scientific articles which may be pertinent to the problem at hand.

The instance described above is, of course, a dead issue. However, the possibility exists that the desires of the Manhattan District, in such matters, may not be as widely known among present staff members as they could be. Unless you believe that all concerned are aware of this requirement, would you cause this information to be circularized.
