The information copy of the following teletype (Ref. 1211) from Caltech to NMD Yorktown, and addressed to the attention of Parsons, was received by BuOrd:

Re CIT job & the following parts have been shipped:

1. On 3 May a special airplane shipment was made on Box NR AH 3112 consisting of a 158-D3 Pent. mold serial 0685 with D32 insert.
2. On 4 May a special airplane shipment was made on Box NR AH 3329, of the same, serial 0779.
3. On 3 May a special airplane shipment was made of Box NR AH 3113 consisting of 1585-D-4 Hex mold serial 0686 with D33 insert.
4. On 2 May a shipment was made via ATC of Box NR AH 30093 and 30094 of two 1583-D5 Pent. molds, serials 0682, 0683.

Langley Field is the destination for all shipments.

5. On 7 May an express carload shipment was made of the following boxes: /A/ 96-1794D1 Pent. boxes and 188-1794D2 Hex. boxes. /B/ On 10 May an express shipment (carload if car available) of 1796 (OC) boxes will be made to you.
6. As soon as material specs can be met, probably this week, the felts will be shipped to you by air.
7. On 10 May an air shipment will be made of 1 overcasting riser 3 EMS-50.
8. On 10 May an air shipment will be made of 2 overcasting hoppers with valves and 5 feeler rods and seals.
9. Pot chucks being trimmed, and this week the cutter grinder is due.
