SUBJECT: Modified M11A2 Fuze.

1. As a result of Mr. Ayers' visit to LaSalle, Colonel Butler's office made further contacts with Westclox, General Electric and the Mechanical and Electric Design Company of America regarding the GE switches.
2. The General Electric Company has agreed to manufacture additional switches using nickel silver contacts to secure a proper weld and which is expected to eliminate the difficulty experienced with the original switches using resistance welded contacts. The General Electric Company also promised to give the new order on switches a reasonable inspection to assure proper manufacture.
3. It is suggested that all of the modified fuzes and switches received to date be examined minutely for striking distance, loose contacts and fatigued springs. Past experience does not indicate the original switches can be relied upon for many operations when used in conjunction with the M11A2 fuze.
