MEMORANDUM TO: Captain W. S. Parsons, P. O. Box 1663, Santa Fe,
New Mexico. (Attn: Dr. R. B. Brode).

SUBJECT: Bomb Fuzes.

1. Reference is made to Dr. Brode's memorandum of 4 September regarding nose impact fuzes and my teletype of 12 September reference EIDM WL-21-T-4810.

2. In discussing this matter with Colonel Butler again on 15 September, he suggested that I forward to you the inclosed Bureau of Ordnance Pamphlet No. 988 on the subject of bomb fuzes. This publication covers the AN-219 Mod. 2 bomb fuze (nose), the AN-M-103 bomb fuze (nose) and all other bomb fuzes, both nose and tail, in use by the Army and Navy. The discussions under each fuze type cover description, functioning, safety features, arming, installation, servicing, packing and marking.

3. Inasmuch as you have drawings on the AN-219 Mod. 2 Navy bomb fuze, these will not be duplicated by this office. However, I have requested Colonel Butler to furnish me with complete drawings of the AN-M-103 and the AN-M-103A1 bomb fuze (nose) together with a short memorandum describing its merits as compared with the AN-219 Mod. 2 Navy fuze.

4. Colonel Butler is procuring two samples of the nose impact fuze in use by the Army for your inspection. These samples will be forwarded to you upon receipt by this office.
