1. The heaviest load on the radio facilities at NPG is on D-1 Day and D Day. It is particularly important that maintenance be readily available during the heavy load period on D Day.
2. It is requested that a representative of AEC Communications be present at the Radio Room at CP during the period H-6 hrs to 1700 hours PST on D Day to handle radio maintenance problems, and to give advice to radio users where necessary. A radio maintenance supervisor of Reynolds Electric Co. is acceptable as a substitute or relief for the above person.
3. The person mentioned in Paragraph 2 should have sufficient manpower resources to get maintenance performed on a rush basis during the period he is on standby duty.
4. The standby period may be ended on knowledge that Rad-Safe, Program 27, and the Air Participation Unit, have completed their radio traffic on D Day.
