SUBJECT: FCDA Structures

Reference: TWX; subject as above, dated September 10, 1952

1. As a result of communications with Mr. Corsbie of DBM, Dr. Doll of DWET, and Cmdr. Saunders, DWET the locations of the four FCDA structures to be built in the Frenchman Flat Area of NTS was determined to be as follows:

a. A base point shall be located 2000' due east of the Tumbler zero in the Frenchman Flat Area. Coordinates of this point are N 746,250; E 716,000.

b. The working point for each building shall be the center of the front face of the building. In each case the front face shall be toward the base point and shall be perpendicular to the line from the working point to the base point.

c. Building Type 1.1, 4200' from base point shall be located at coordinates N 747,167.39; E 711,901.72.

d. Building Type 1.1, 6500' from base point shall be located at coordinates N 747,270.84; E 709,565.87.

e. Building Type 1.2, 4200' from base point shall be located at coordinates N 746,849.98; E 711,843.39.

f. Building Type 1.2, 6500' from base point shall be located at coordinates N 746,849.98; E 709,528.04.

2. It is requested that construction begin immediately on these four structures. Until such time as a program number is assigned, these buildings shall be known by the designations given above (building type and distance).
