Dear Dr. Larson:

With reference to your letter of October 10, the intention of the experiment was to ascertain whether there were appreciable dimensional changes in the slugs at high levels of irradiation. It now appears that the levels are not higher than those normally experienced by our slugs at Hanford. Therefore, to get as much out of the experiment as possible, the slugs should be irradiated for an overall of about five months.

I trust this gives the information desired. I happen to be leaving for Chicago immediately but will be back the first of next week if you desire further discussion about the matter.
