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Lee Meyer of SRP called on September 25, 1964, to review the status of the low grade material which will be available soon for isotope power source applications. I stated that the first batch of material will be about 20% plutonium-238 and the total quantity of plutonium about 4 kilograms. They are planning to make this material available as the oxide and will hold it at SRP until we are ready to receive it, sometime after March 1965.

Lee Meyer stated that the second HM recovery campaign is scheduled to start in February 1965, and be completed in June 1965. The third recovery campaign is scheduled to start in November 1965, and be completed by June 1966. The total quantity of plutonium expected to be made available from each of the second and third recovery campaigns is estimated to be 6 to 10 kilograms. These operations are to be scheduled into existing facilities without interference to the plutonium-238 production for DMA use.
