Recently, Ed Staley contacted me and asked me to give you some information on classification concerning the use of the terms "plastic parts" and "metal parts" in relation to shipments to Pinellas Peninsula.

The classification guides issued by the AEC inform us that the association of timers, transducers, and other explosive components with General Electric Milwaukee (GEXM) or General Electric Pinellas Peninsula (GEXP) is Secret-Restricted Data. Since Mound Laboratory manufactures these explosive components for use at these sites, it is necessary to classify this association at the Secret-Restricted Data level.

To avoid needless classification of innocuous documents such as shipping papers, we have designated the parts we are shipping to Pinellas Peninsula as "plastic parts" and "metal parts" not otherwise identified by name.
