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Telephone Conversation with Bob Rowland (CHR) 3/1/74.

1. The commission advises that the two abstracts dealing with plutonium measurements in human subjects are suitable for publication in the program of the Radiation Society meeting if two conditions are met:
 - (a) The complete anonymity of the subjects must be assured.
 - (b) The relationship between the patient and his physician should in no way be endangered by the publication of the abstracts.
2. I told Rowland that my opinion of the way to proceed with this matter was that he should talk with Dr. Waterhouse (Univ. of Rochester) and obtain her written approval to submit the abstracts.

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
