SEARCH FOR LOST TO FOLLOW-UP PATIENTS

In the recent past, BER and Division of Inspection staff have discussed the need for a missing persons search for those patients injected with plutonium during 1945 and 1946 who have been lost to follow-up. This is a request for an official investigation to ascertain the identification of the patient in one case, the outcome of all three cases and the whereabouts of any who might now be alive. The cases are identified in Dr. Durbin's article as CHI-3 (name unknown), HP-10 and HP-12.

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
