The following listed bone specimens have been returned to the Bone and Dosimetry Groups facilities for selection of suitable endosteal surface areas for alpha quantitation:

- 1) A3, 3 pieces (both ends) and 1 1/2" segment of shaft
- 2) K9 B, 11 pieces of diaphysis
- 3) E2 A, 5 pieces of ends
- 4) K5 D, 4 pieces of pmt
- 5) K5 E, 4 pieces of ms
- 6) K5 F, 3 pieces of ms

Dr. Schlenker will select several small areas (1 cm<sup>2</sup>) of smooth, flat endosteal surfaces to use in his studies. The endosteal surfaces will be cut from the cortical bone segments. All remaining materials will be returned to you. A statement listing the specimens we are keeping for study, and listing the weight of each sample will be sent to you at a later date.
