RADIATION WORKERS' FOLLOWUP

The Division of Biomedical and Environmental Research, Office of the Assistant Secretary for Environment, DOE Headquarters, has informed the Oak Ridge Operations Office of its intent to establish a medical followup of all DOE and DOE contractor workers exposed to 5 rem or more in any one year. This activity will be accomplished through expansion of the existing followup program at the DOE REACTS facility in Oak Ridge. This facility is operated for DOE by the Oak Ridge Associated Universities.

To initiate this expanded program, the Oak Ridge Associated Universities has been requested to immediately undertake construction of a roster of all workers of interest, and to develop a management plan for the actual medical followup of individuals for Headquarters' evaluation.

Insofar as RL is concerned, it is requested that the following data be supplied for each worker who has received a whole body penetrating radiation exposure equal to or greater than 5 rem.

- Worker's Name
- Social Security Number
- Other Number (Employment or Military Service No.)
- Sex
- Race
- Date of Birth
- First Date of Hire
- Last Date of Termination
- Continuous Hire (Yes or No)
- Date of Death, If Known
- Place of Death, If Known
- Dates of 5 rem or Greater External Exposure
- Actual Measurements of Radiation Exposures
- Total "Career" External Exposure to Date


