DEVELOPMENT OF A PORTABLE BLOOD IRRADIATOR

DHSC 78-8 has reviewed your memo to me of October 13, 1978, and has the following comments.

At this time, the information concerning possible human application of the subject device is too vague to permit decision making by the committee.

There is a very strong interest in looking at this one very closely when it becomes ready to move forward.

We hope that you will identify that step as soon as you can, and prepare yourself for an extended oral presentation to the committee. This will hold whether you continue to be involved personally, or whether the proposal becomes a complete "transfer of technology" issue.
