We would appreciate your help in reviewing the research proposals of Dr. Paulsen and Dr. Heller in Seattle, Washington, December 14 and 15, 1967.

The purpose of this review will be to:

1. establish the significant progress that research in your laboratory has made to date;
2. determine the effort and time necessary to complete the evaluation of irradiation effects on human testicular tissues and function;
3. review the investigations for which biometrics is of particular significance and the changes in direction brought about or anticipated through the addition of Dr. O'Keefe to the project;
4. a review of the biometrics panel recommendations resulting from their visit at the project on September 14, 1967;
5. discuss new studies envisioned that may be of overall significance to establishing the radiation response of reproductive tissues in humans including a status report of the neutron irradiation effects studies by Dr. Paulsen; and
6. executive session.
